

**Minutes — 2000 — Making Our Voices Heard**  
**ALASBO Annual Meeting**  
**December 6, 2000**

President Lucienne Harger called the meeting to order at 12:45 and declared a quorum present.

**Minutes:**

Marysia Ochej moved to approve the minutes from the last meeting which were distributed with conference packets. Eddy Jeans seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

**Treasurer's Report:**

Holly Sager reported ALASBO recorded Revenues of \$72,626 against Expenditures of \$74,732 during the past year. The organization currently has a fund balance of \$55,062.28. The checking account contains \$35,622.96. The savings account contains \$510.60. The certificate of deposit contains \$18,928.72.

**Scholarships:**

Holly Sager reported there were 89 applicants for last year's ALASBO scholarship program. Laura Bailey of Anchor Point received a \$1,000 scholarship. Stephanie Henderson of Anchorage, and Ashley Badger of Juneau each received \$500 scholarships.
