Guidelines

The Alaska Association of School Business Officials (ALASBO) will award one scholarships for the upcoming school year based on the following guidelines:

- 1. There will be one \$1,000 scholarship.
- 2. The scholarship will be available to high school seniors.
- 3. The applicant must intend to enroll in an accredited 2 or 4-year college or university in a degree related course of study or a vocational education program.
- 4. Applications must be postmarked no later than <u>March 31</u> and must include the following:
 - 1) Grade transcripts with an accumulative GPA, computed by a school registrar.
 - 2) SAT and ACT scores highlighted.
 - 3) List of extra-curricular activities, awards or letters received, offices held, and related achievements.
 - 4) A handwritten or typed (double spaced) essay of 250-300 words. Subject: My Career Goals and Why I Have Chosen Them.
 - 5) A letter of recommendation from the school principal or a teacher.
- 5. The scholarship award will be paid after May 30, on proof of college, university or vocational school enrollment as described in #3 above.
